

1st Reading: (Isaiah 62:1-5). When this was written Jerusalem lay in ruins and the plight of God's people was like that of a widow deprived of her children. It announces a joyful feast for God and his people.

2nd Reading: (Cor. 12:4-11). St Paul tells us that, through there as many different gifts around us, they all come from God's Spirit, and should be used for the good of all.

Gospel: (John 2:1-12). This relates the first of the signs given by Jesus, when at a wedding in Cana he changed water into wine at the request of his mother.

Contactless Payments for your collection.

This week we have eventually received our new Contactless Payment machine for use at St Gregory's. This means that you can make a donation (pay your collection) using a contactless debit or credit card. The machine has three "set" amounts. A default of £3, and options for £5 or £10. This is part of a Diocesan trial (only five parishes will be using the machines) and its results will be monitored closely by the Diocesan Treasurers Offices. If you would wish to use the machine –but are unsure please ask and we will assist you.

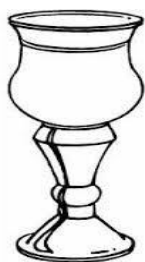
